

A moment with God the Holy Spirit

Before discovering my gift and my missionary profile – to be lived unhurried, alone or as a family

This is not a personality test, it is a time of discernment: the tool serves prayer, never the reverse.

1 · Stop and call on the Spirit It is He who distributes the gifts “as He wills,” not I. I grow quiet and I ask for His help. – *1 Corinthians 12:11*

2 · Listen to the Word I read slowly of the diversity of gifts within one body, and I ask: what is God underlining for me? – *1 Corinthians 12:4-11 · Romans 12:4-8*

3 · Look back over my life A gift leaves two traces: fruit in others and a deep joy in me. Where have I already seen them? – *Matthew 7:20*

4 · Answer in truth I answer without flattering or belittling myself. The question is not “who am I?” but “Lord, how do You want to send me?”

5 · Have it confirmed by the body A gift is confirmed in the community: I ask two people who know me, “where do you see me bearing fruit?” – *1 Peter 4:10*

6 · Give thanks and offer myself The result is not a label, it is a call. I give thanks and I offer myself: “Here am I, send me.” – *Isaiah 6:8*

“Holy Spirit, open my eyes to what You have placed in me – not to make me great, but to serve. Here am I.”
